

“ST-FANS” CONTEST
Official Rules (the “Rules”)

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.

1. CONTEST AND CONTEST PERIOD

The “**ST-FANS**” Contest (the “**Contest**”) is held by Les Rôtisseries St-Hubert Ltée (the “**Organizer**”). The Contest begins on Tuesday, January 9, 2024, at 11 h 00 min 01 sec Eastern Time (ET) and ends on Monday, March 4, 2024, at 23 h 59 min 59 sec ET (the “**Contest Period**”). The clock used by the Organizer will be the official clock to determine the date and time of receipt of an Entry (as such term is defined below).

2. ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible to enter the Contest, a person must meet the following criteria at the time of his or her Entry into the Contest: he or she is a legal resident of Canada and has reached the legal age of majority in his or her province or territory of residence (a “**Participant**” or, collectively, the “**Participants**”).

Are excluded the employees, officers, directors, shareholders, agents, representatives or mandataries of the Organizer and those of its subsidiaries, related companies, franchisees, affiliates, advertising and promotional agencies and suppliers of prizes, as well as the members of their immediate family (father, mother, sisters, brothers, children), legal or common-law spouse, and all individuals with whom these persons are domiciled, whether or not these persons are related to each other.

3. HOW TO PARTICIPATE

There are three (3) ways of obtaining a Unique Participation Code, which must then be used to enter the Contest online, on the website: contest.st-hubert.com (the “**Contest Website**”). A valid e-mail address is required to enter the Contest.

A. OBTAINING A UNIQUE PARTICIPATION CODE

i. By purchasing an Admissible St-Hubert Meal at a Participating St-Hubert Rotisserie

During the Contest Period, the Participant must obtain a “**Contest Card**” displaying a “**Unique Participation Code**”, in one of the “**Participating St-Hubert Rotisseries**” by purchasing an “**Admissible St-Hubert Meal**”. The list of Participating St-Hubert Rotisseries is available in **Schedule A** to the Rules. The list of Admissible St-Hubert Meals is available in **Schedule B** to the Rules. The Admissible St-Hubert Meal may be ordered on the premises, at the take-out counter or by placing an order for delivery with a Participating St-Hubert Rotisserie. The Participant will receive a Contest Card at the same time as the bill issued for the Admissible St-Hubert Meal. The Participant will receive one (1) Contest Card with one (1) Unique Participation Code for each Admissible St-Hubert Meal purchased, except where Schedule B provides for a greater number of Contest Cards to be awarded for a specific Admissible St-Hubert Meal. For example, a Participant having purchased four (4) Admissible St-Hubert Meals will generally receive four (4) Contest Cards. The Participant can then visit the Contest Website to enter the Contest by completing the steps described in section 3(B).

ii. By purchasing an Admissible St-Hubert Product at a participating retailer

During the Contest Period, the Participant must obtain a Unique Participation Code by purchasing an “**Admissible St-Hubert Product**” at a participating retailer. The complete list of Admissible St-Hubert Products is available in **Schedule C** of these Rules. The Participant must then go to “st-fans-instore.com” in order to submit a photo of the invoice for the Admissible St-Hubert Product(s) purchased and complete all mandatory fields of the form by providing the Participant’s first name, last name, e-mail address, the name and quantity of the Admissible St-Hubert Product(s) purchased and the invoice number for the

Admissible St-Hubert Product(s) purchased. An invoice number may be submitted only once during the Contest Period. The Participant must therefore include in a single form all Admissible St-Hubert Products appearing on the same invoice, in order to obtain a Unique Participation Code for each Admissible St-Hubert Product purchased during the same transaction. Once the invoice photo and form have been submitted, the Participant will receive by e-mail one (1) Unique Participation Code for each Admissible St-Hubert Product purchased. For example, a Participant who has purchased four (4) Admissible St-Hubert Products will receive four (4) Unique Participation Codes. The Participant may then go to the Contest Website to sign-up by completing the steps described in section 3(B)

iii. By sending a text to the Organizer

During the Contest Period, in order to obtain a Unique Participation Code, a Participant may also write to st-hubert@criagence.ca, by email. The Participant must explain, in 300 words, his or her interest in the Contest and the Organizer. The submitted text must be original (not copied) and must not violate any applicable laws, including any applicable intellectual property laws. A Participant cannot submit the same text more than once and cannot reuse a text already submitted to the Organizer as part of a previous version of the Contest. Once the Participant's request is received and analyzed, a Unique Participation Code will be sent to the Participant, by email, by the Organizer. The Participant can then visit the Contest Website to enter the Contest by completing the steps described in section 3(B).

B. SIGNING UP

Once the Participant has obtained a Unique Participation Code, the Participant will then need to complete the following steps in order to sign up for the Contest:

- i. The Participant must visit the Contest Website: contest.st-hubert.com;
- ii. The Participant must enter the Unique Participation Code. A maximum of five (5) Unique Participation Codes may be entered during a single Day (a "Day" being a period of twenty-four (24) consecutive hours);
- iii. The Participant must fill in all mandatory fields of the participation form by providing his or her email address, first name and last name, date of birth and postal code. By participating in the Contest, the Participant agrees to comply with these Rules and with the Organizer's Privacy Policy;
- iv. By entering the Contest, each Participant acknowledges and agrees that the Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by, nor is associated with Aeroplan Inc., Air Canada, or any of their subsidiaries and affiliates, and that the Organizer is fully responsible for the conduct and administration of the Contest, including the selection of winners and the distribution of prizes.

GRAND PRIZES

- i. Once the Participant clicks on the "next" button in the participation form, he or she immediately obtains one "Entry" for the Grand Prizes draw per Unique Participation Code entered. There is a maximum of five (5) Entries per Day per Participant. Each Entry gives one (1) chance of winning one of the Grand Prizes. For example, if the Participant entered the maximum allowed number of five (5) Unique Participation Codes per Day, he or she obtains five (5) chances of winning one of the five (5) Grand Prizes.
- ii. In order to obtain one (1) additional Entry for the Grand Prizes draw, the Participant will have the possibility to subscribe to the Organizer's newsletter. This additional Entry can only be effected once per Participant during the Contest Period, irrespective of the email address used, and is not applicable to the Instant Prizes.
- iii. The Participant may also obtain one (1) additional Entry for the Grand Prizes draw by sharing the Contest either via his or her Facebook page or by email, by clicking on the designated Contest Website icons. Only one (1) additional Entry per Participant for the Grand Prizes draw will be provided during the Contest Period,

irrespective of the means used to share the Contest or of the number of times the Contest is shared. This additional Entry is not applicable to the Instant Prizes.

A Participant who shares the Contest on Facebook agrees to comply with Facebook's Terms of Service available at <https://www.facebook.com/terms.php>. The Contest is not authorized, sponsored or endorsed by Facebook.

NUMBER OF POSSIBLE ENTRIES FOR THE GRAND PRIZES: (i) a maximum of five (5) Entries per Day per Participant during the Contest Period, for a total number of two hundred and eighty (280) Entries; (ii) a maximum of one (1) additional Entry for the Grand Prizes draw per Participant for subscribing to the Organizer's newsletter during the entire Contest Period; and (iii) one (1) additional Entry for the Grand Prizes draw for sharing the Contest on Facebook or by email, per Participant, during the entire Contest Period. The Grand Prizes will be awarded by random draw. Five (5) Grand Prizes are available.

Limitation. Maximum of one (1) Grand Prize per Participant for the entire Contest Period.

INSTANT PRIZES

- iv. In order to obtain an Entry to win an Instant Prize, the Participant must play the *Overtime* game on the Contest Website (the "**Game**"). Each shot gives the Participant a chance to win an Instant Prize. The number of available shots corresponds to the number of Unique Participation Codes entered in the participation form. If the Participant is selected to win an Instant Prize, a mention will appear on the screen to indicate that he or she was selected to win an Instant Prize. The chances of winning do not depend on having shot the right target in the Game. Playing suffices to activate one's chances to win.

The awarding of Instant Prizes is done by an algorithm. Selection times are chosen randomly by the algorithm. The first shot registered by a Participant after a given selection time will determine the Participant being selected as a potential winner.

NUMBER OF POSSIBLE ENTRIES FOR AN INSTANT PRIZE: a maximum of five (5) Entries per Day per Participant during the Contest Period, for a total number of two hundred and eighty (280) Entries.

Limitations. One (1) Instant Prize per Day per Participant. A Participant may therefore win more than one (1) Instant Prize during the Contest Period.

The Participant must submit each Entry personally. The Participant may only use one (1) email address for this Contest. Mechanically reproduced, forged or altered Entries are void. The Organizer is not responsible for lost, late, undelivered or invalid Entries, which will be disqualified. All Entries become the exclusive property of the Organizer and will not be returned to the Participants. The Participant will receive an acknowledgement of receipt by email for his or her Entry for the Grand Prizes draw.

Any attempt by a Participant to obtain more than the stated number of Entries by using multiple email addresses, social media accounts, identities, registrations, logins, or any other methods will void that Participant's Entries and that Participant may be disqualified at the Organizer's sole discretion. Use of any automated system (including, but not limited to, Entries submitted by using any robot, script, macro, or other automated service) to participate is prohibited and will result in the disqualification of the Participant. In the event of a dispute as to the identity of any person who submitted an Entry, the authorized account holder of the email address and/or Facebook account used to enter will be deemed to be the Participant. The "**authorized account holder**" is the natural person assigned to the email address or Facebook account by the internet access provider, the online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning the email address account or the Facebook account. Selected Participants may be required to show proof of being the authorized account holder.

4. PRIZES

- A. GRAND PRIZES.** There will be five (5) Grand Prizes available to be won during the Contest, each consisting of one (1) trip to Vancouver for two (2) people, namely the Winner, as this term is defined below, and one (1) guest, as more fully described below.

The total approximative value of the Grand Prizes is fifty thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$50,750 CAD). Each Grand Prize has a value of approximately ten thousand one hundred and fifty dollars (\$10,150 CAD). Each Grand Prize consists of the following elements:

- a. Two (2) Air Canada® Economy class round-trip tickets for the Grand Prize Winner and one (1) travelling companion onboard flights operated by Air Canada® (including flights operated by Air Canada Rouge® or under the Air Canada Express® banner) departing from the major Canadian airport served by Air Canada closest to the Winner's place of residence to Vancouver International Airport (YVR) in Vancouver, Canada, on the dates chosen by Air Canada. Specific seat selection is at the sole discretion of Air Canada. Other applicable conditions are detailed below;
- b. Round-trip ground transportation between Vancouver International Airport (YVR) in Vancouver, Canada and hotel in Vancouver;
- c. Five (5) nights in a 3-star rating hotel or higher in Vancouver, Canada, in a double-occupancy room. Exact hotel to be selected by Air Canada at its sole discretion;
- d. Two (2) regular season game tickets to a Montreal Canadiens away game at Rogers Arena in Vancouver vs. the Vancouver Canucks during the 2024-2025 NHL regular hockey season. Date and time will be determined by the Organizer depending on game availabilities;
- e. \$1,500 CAD in prepaid credit cards;
- f. Fifty thousand (50,000) Aeroplan points; and
- g. Two (2) Air Canada gift bags containing branded material.

The Grand Prizes are subject to the following terms and conditions:

- i. The approximative value of each Grand Prize is ten thousand one hundred and fifty dollars (\$10,150 CAD). The real value of each Grand Prize may vary depending on flight fares fluctuation, the departure point in Canada and applicable trip dates. No monetary compensation will be provided in case of difference between the approximate and real value of the Grand Prize. The Grand Prize must be accepted as awarded and used in accordance with the relevant terms and conditions applicable at the time of redemption, including Air Canada's general conditions of carriage publicly available at: www.aircanada.ca/ca/en/aco/home/legal/conditions-carriage-tariffs.html.
- ii. Travel dates will be selected by Air Canada, at its sole discretion, based on the NHL calendar for the Montreal Canadiens vs. Vancouver Canucks game at Rogers Arena in Vancouver. If selected, the Grand Prize Winner and travel companion must be available to travel on the specific dates selected by Air Canada. Final travel dates and time will be determined by Air Canada in accordance with the operating schedule at the time of the trip. No changes are permitted to travel dates, reservations, tickets or date of the hockey game. Each person will be contacted by Air Canada to confirm the travel conditions. The Organizer is not liable for delayed or cancelled flights, or for any other event out of the control of the Organizer which could prevent or delay the trip or affect the hockey game, accommodation reservations or any other activity booked by the Winner and guest at their destination.
- iii. The Winner and guest must travel along the same itinerary: they must leave from the same airport and travel to the same destination indicated in the present Rules, on the same dates and on the same flight(s).
- iv. The Winner and guest are solely responsible for (i) obtaining, at their own expense, all required travel documents for the trip and ensuring their validity for the duration of the trip, including, without limitation, a passport, any travel visas that may be required and any proof of vaccination or COVID-19 screening and (ii) complying with all health requirements in force at the time of travel. No monetary compensation will be provided in the event that the trip or a planned activity at the destination is

prevented due to a failure of the Winner and/or guest to comply with applicable requirements in Canada at the time of the trip.

- v. Each Grand Prize Winner understands and acknowledges and will ensure that their guest understands and acknowledges the risks related to the spread of infectious or contagious diseases and understand it remains their responsibility to take the necessary precautions applicable to any health hazards, including but not limited to COVID-19.
- vi. The Winner and their guest are solely responsible for obtaining, at their own expense, personal, medical and travel insurance prior to departure.
- vii. In the event that a force majeure event makes it impossible to book the trip (i.e., a travel ban takes effect before the trip is booked by the Winner), the Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to provide the Winner with the monetary value of the trip, as indicated in these Rules.
- viii. Grand Prize Winners and their guest are responsible for any and all costs, surcharges, fees, charges, expenses and taxes not expressly described herein including, without limitation, ground transportation, gratuities, merchandise, telephone calls, personal expenses of any nature for overnight layovers, meals and beverages, service charges, in-flight meals and entertainment, costs incurred to and from the departure point (as the Grand Prize originates and terminates at such departure point), obtaining sufficient personal travel insurance prior to departure; obtaining and carrying all necessary travel documentation, such as passports and visas, and complying with entry, health, safety, customs and immigration regulations and requirements. These requirements are subject to change without notice.
- ix. Travel does not qualify for Aeroplan points accumulation or for mileage/points accumulation in any other frequent flyer program.
- x. Grand Prizes are not transferable, not upgradeable, not refundable, and not redeemable for cash nor valid on Air Canada Vacations packages. Stopovers and multi-city itineraries are not permitted.
- xi. Aeroplan points have no cash value but are redeemable under the Aeroplan program for flights and other rewards. The retail value of rewards obtained using Aeroplan points will vary depending on a range of factors, including the type of reward issued, details of which may be found at <https://www.aircanada.com/ca/en/aco/home/aeroplan.html>. Aeroplan points may be redeemed only in accordance with the General Terms & Conditions of the Aeroplan program. - xii. Photos used in advertising or promotional materials for the Contest (including, but not limited to, print advertising, the Contest Website, electronic and web banner advertising) are provided for reference only and do not constitute a guarantee with respect to the trip.

All costs and expenses other than those specifically provided for above as being included in the Grand Prizes will be the responsibility of the Winner and guest.

B. INSTANT PRIZES. There is a total of one thousand five hundred and fifty (1,550) Instant Prizes available to be won during the Contest Period. The total approximate value of the Instant Prizes is one hundred and forty thousand four hundred and sixty-two dollars (\$140,462 CAD). The approximate value of the Instant Prizes is in Canadian dollars and does not include the amount of applicable taxes in the province or territory of residence of the Instant Winners.

Remarks regarding the lease for the 2024 Ford Bronco Sport TI Big Bend for a 36-month period: One thirty-six (36) month lease of all-wheel-drive Ford Bronco Sport TI Big Bend 2024 (maximum of 20,000 km/year, non-cumulative) having an approximate value of twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000 CAD) (the “Lease”), which amount includes the fees associated with the delivery of the vehicle to the location designated below and inspection fees, as well as the applicable taxes in the province or territory of residence of the Instant Winner, but excludes vehicle license and registration fees of the vehicle and any other fees associated with the Lease. The following terms and conditions apply to the Lease:

1. The Instant Winner will be required to sign and enter into the standard lease agreement from the dealership Jacques Olivier Ford Inc. doing business as OlivierFord Saint-Hubert (“Olivier Ford”), and the terms of said agreement will apply to the Lease. The Instant Winner may be required to pay for any additional options or extras, such as accessories, selected by the Instant Winner, if such options are made available by Olivier Ford, at its sole discretion;
2. The Instant Winner is responsible for maintaining their license, insurance, and vehicle registration for the whole duration of the Lease, as well as excess mileage and abnormal or excessive wear and tear, plus all vehicle maintenance costs including fuel. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, if the limit of 20,000 km/year (non-cumulative) is exceeded, additional fees will have to be paid by the Instant Winner for the excess mileage in accordance with the terms of the standard lease agreement. At the end of the Lease, the vehicle must be returned by the Instant Winner to Olivier Ford in an acceptable condition pursuant to the terms of the standard lease agreement, failing which the Instant Winner will be required to pay the repair costs deemed necessary by Olivier Ford in accordance with the terms of the standard lease agreement;

In the event that the vehicle selected for the Lease is not available, for whatever reason, the Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to substitute a vehicle of equal or greater value among similar Ford models or to offer the Instant Winner the equivalent value of the Lease in cash.

Remarks regarding the Montreal Canadiens hockey game in a suite and the pairs of tickets for a Montreal Canadiens hockey game: The Organizer bears no responsibility for the cancellation, delay, suspension or postponement of the hockey games. The Participant acknowledges that the progress of the hockey game is beyond the Organizer’s control. The Instant Prizes are only valid for the hockey games at the dates mentioned below.

- **Montreal Canadiens hockey game in a suite:** The date of the hockey game for this Instant Prize is March 30, 2024, at the Bell Centre in Montreal. This Instant Prize consists of access to one (1) suite for the Instant Winner and eleven (11) guests, including host services in the suite, two (2) accesses to the Bell Centre parking and non-alcoholic and alcoholic drinks. All costs and expenses other than those specifically provided for above as being included in the Instant Prize will be the responsibility of the Instant Winner and of each guest, notably, but without limitation, tips and meals. The Instant Winner and guests agree to comply with the terms, conditions and rules applicable to the Bell Centre suite.

- **Pair of tickets for a Montreal Canadiens hockey game on the Club Desjardins level:** The dates of the hockey games for this Instant Prize are Tuesday, March 12, 2024 (8 pairs of tickets), and Tuesday, April 9, 2024 (8 pairs of tickets), at the Bell Centre in Montreal. The exact seating for the tickets on the Club Desjardins level is at the Organizer's discretion, who cannot guarantee contiguous seats. Each ticket includes access to the Bell Centre's Salon Desjardins, including food (in the form of culinary stations and buffets), as well as an assortment of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. The Instant Prize also includes food and non-alcoholic fountain drinks at selected Bell Centre fast food concessions. Transportation, parking and all other expenses not included in the Prize are the responsibility of each Instant Winner of the hockey game tickets and guest.

Remarks regarding the Interac Cash Instant Prizes: The "Interac Cash" Instant Prize, each consisting of \$1000 cash, will be awarded to Instant Winners via Interac e-Transfer with notification sent to their e-mail address provided at the time of entry. Each Instant Winner must have a valid e-mail address and either a banking app or an online banking service with their participating financial institution to be eligible to win the Interac Cash Instant Prize. Once the Interac e-Transfer has been sent to the Instant Winner with notification by email, each Instant Winner is solely responsible for depositing their Interac Cash Instant Prize into their bank account.

The total approximative value of the Grand Prizes and the Instant Prizes (collectively, the "Prizes" and each a "Prize") is one hundred and ninety-one thousand two hundred and twelve Canadian dollars (\$191, 212 CAD).

Prizes will only be awarded to the persons whose full name and other valid information appear on the participation form. All Prizes must be accepted as they are described in these Rules and cannot, under any circumstances, be, in whole or in part, transferred to another person, substituted for another Prize or exchanged for money, except at the sole discretion of the Organizer, as provided by these Rules. The Winners and Instant Winners will not be entitled to the difference, if any, between the approximate value and the real value of their Prize. If a portion of a Prize is not used, in whole or in part, no monetary compensation will be provided.

At any time and for any reason whatsoever, the Organizer reserves the right to substitute, in whole or in part, a Prize as described in these Rules with a prize of the same nature and of equivalent or greater monetary value, or, in its sole discretion, to provide the monetary value of a Prize (or of a component of a Prize) as indicated in these Rules.

5. PRIZE SELECTION AND AWARD

A. GRAND PRIZES

On March 7, 2024, at the offices of the marketing agency Cri Communication Inc., doing business as Cri Agence, located at 85 St-Paul St., Suite 120, Montreal (Quebec) H2Y 3V4, at around 14h00 ET, there will be a draw which will consist of selecting five (5) Entries at random from all eligible Entries received during the Contest Period for the Grand Prizes.

The odds of winning a Grand Prize depend on the number of eligible Entries received during the Contest Period for the Grand Prizes.

The Organizer will contact the Participants who were selected during the Grand Prize draw within the twenty-four (24) hours following the draw, by email, at the email address provided at the time of their participation.

Each selected Participant must then respond to the Organizer at the latest within forty-eight (48) hours following the Organizer's above-mentioned notice, in accordance with the instructions provided by the Organizer.

If the Organizer cannot contact a selected Participant or if a selected Participant does not respond to the Organizer within the aforementioned delay, for whatever reason, the Organizer reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to proceed with another draw in order to try to award the Grand Prize and the above-mentioned contact procedure will apply. The Organizer cannot, under any circumstances, be held to award more than five (5) Grand Prizes or to award a Grand Prize other than in accordance with these Rules.

To be declared the winner of a Grand Prize (the “**Winner**”), the selected Participant must satisfy the Contest admissibility criteria and comply with the following requirements:

1. Sign a “**Release**” which will be sent by the Organizer. This document must be returned to the Organizer within the forty-eight (48) hours following its sending to the selected Participant or within the delay otherwise stipulated by the Organizer;
